Keynote Speaker: Dr. Frank Pezzella

Dr. Pezzella, associate professor at John Jay College of Criminal Justice, has written and spoken widely about hate crime in the United States. He is the author of more than 17 articles and two major books: *The Measurement of Hate Crime in America*, and *Hate Crime Statutes: A Public Policy and Law Enforcement Dilemma*. Dr. Pezzella has researched mass shootings as well as isolated instances of bias crime, and is considered one of the nation's leading experts on the topic.
