WIC PROGRAM

What is WIC ?

WIC is a federal program that focuses on Special Supplemental Nutrition for Women, Infants, and Children. Pregnant women have the opportunity to seek guidance on child development and create a plan that aligns with their preferences and needs.

Who is Eligible?

People with low income can't always afford buying healthy foods like vegetables and fruits. WIC is a program that can help people in that area to make sure that families meet their nutritional needs.

Individuals that are eligible for WIC are :

- Individuals at the start of pregnancy up to six weeks after delivery.
- Breastfeeding mothers up to their infant's first birthday.
- Non-breastfeeding and post-delivery individuals up to 6 months after giving birth.

What are the Benefits ?

Since October 1st 2023, WIC adjusted the amount of money that can be spent monthly on fruits and vegetables. CVB- known as Cash Value Benefit, is used for purchasing fruits and vegetables that are available at approved stores and farmer's markets all year long.

What are different ways of using your CVB ?

1.Using your EWIC card in approved stores
